



## Gerald Chikozho Mazarire

Gerald Chikozho Mazarire is an Associate Professor of History at the Midlands State University in Zimbabwe. He earned his DPhil in History from the University of Zimbabwe in 2010. He has held various research positions at the Universities of Edinburgh (UK) and Stellenbosch (SA). He is a Fellow of the American Council of Learned Societies' African Humanities Program. He was the inaugural Fellow of the Africa-Oxford Initiative Visiting Research Program based at St Peter's College, Oxford in 2017. He is an editor of *Critical African Studies* and sits on the editorial and Advisory Boards of the *Journal of Southern African Studies* and *Kronos: Southern African Histories*. Professor Mazarire has published widely on Zimbabwean pre-colonial history, Historiography, Shona (Karanga) Oral Traditions, the Armed Struggle in Southern Africa, Land and Restitution. He is actively involved in community history projects and mentoring initiatives for young scholars interested in the history of Africa in general and Zimbabwe in particular.
