Dr. Marci Shore is a history professor at Yale University. She will join the Munk School of Global Affairs & Public Policy in fall 2025 as Chair in European Intellectual History, supported by the Temerty Endowment for Ukrainian Studies. She specializes in 20th- and 21st-century Central and Eastern European intellectual history. Her books include *The Ukrainian Night*, *The Taste of Ashes*, and *Caviar and Ashes*. A Guggenheim Fellow, she is working on a history of phenomenology in East-Central Europe. She has been a visiting fellow at the Institut für die Wissenschaften vom Menschen in Vienna and earned her Ph.D. from Stanford in 2001.
